

MINUTES OF THE FIRST ANNUAL MEETING OF THE BRUNY ISLAND COMMUNITY ASSOCIATION HELD ON SATURDAY, 1ST NOVEMBER AT 4.30 P.M. AT THE BRUNY ISLAND DISTRICT SCHOOL, ALONNAH.

PRESENT: 45 members including the President, Mr. Tom Mulcahy who presented the report of the interim committee for the period since incorporation on 12 June.

Committee meetings were held on 21 June and 2 August. During the first four and a half months the Association had completed works totalling \$4,000 of which the State Government had contributed a \$2,000 grant.

The net proceeds of the Easter Ox Roast, namely \$1,327.75 plus subscriptions enabled the Association to pay \$1,380 to the Council for fencing materials and gate for the recreation ground, seed and dressing, cricket matting, paint and other miscellaneous items. \$1,900 was spent on sealing the tennis courts.
