<p>28 October</p> <p>2pm Adventure Bay Hall</p>	<p>Bruny Island Arts presents “Lunawanna Kiss” & “Water” with Julius Schwing.</p> <p>Two short films produced on Bruny Island with local performers and artists.</p>
<p>Everyday 10-3pm Adventure Bay</p>	<p>Bligh Museum</p> <p>On display are maps, documents, paintings and artefacts recalling the visits to Adventure Bay of explorers such as Furneaux, Cook, Bligh and others. The building is constructed from handmade bricks brought from the convict kiln at Variety Bay.</p>
<p>Thurs - Monday 10-3pm Killora Road, North Bruny</p>	<p>Quarantine Station</p> <p>The site incorporates many different aspects of human occupancy, from early Aboriginal occupation by the Nuenonne to the present day. Its history includes free settlement in 1856 establishment of a State maritime quarantine station in 1884; internment of German nationals in 1914; quarantine of soldiers returning from the war, during the Influenza Pandemic 1919; Plant Quarantine usage and techniques from 1955 – 1986.</p>

The remains of a pilot station built by William Lawrence in 1831, a brick works and St Peter’s Church.</p> <p>*(A 2pm tour will only be offered if needed)</p>
