Bruny Island Community Library

is a community driven entity, managed and staffed by volunteers.

Library services began following the official opening held on Saturday 27th August 2005.

Main funding sources have been the Tasmanian Community Fund, Kingborough Council, Bruny Island Cork Club, Bruny Island Community Association. The Kingborough Council also provides assistance by way of concessions for operating expenses, rental of premises etc.

The bulk of the material on our shelves has been donated. The Kingborough Council has also been very generous, providing occasional grants for the purchase of new books.

Other donors include the island's BIRCH group and the Health Library, whose own libraries are now amalgamated with that of our Community Library.

An important element in the early stages was the strong support throughout our community, and we are indebted to all those residents who generously donated and continue to donate part of their personal libraries and so assist us to maintain this valuable community amenity.

Our library is staffed by a group of enthusiastic local volunteers and new recruits are always welcome!

Only financial members may borrow books/ material from the library.
